SECTION 1: CONCEPT NOTE Title: The Beauty of Resilience

ASPAS launches a national photography competition to document the impact of Cyclone Ditwah and the strength of Sri Lankan communities in its aftermath. The winning images will form a Special Official Selection and be showcased during the 2026 USA Exhibition Tour in Los Angeles and Washington D.C.

SECTION 2: THEMATIC CATEGORIES

1. Nature's Power

Images capturing the strength and impact of Cyclone Ditwah, dramatic skies, rough seas, and environmental changes.

2. Hands of Hope

Photographs showing people supporting each other during and after the cyclone, highlighting courage and unity.

3. Green Recovery

Images showing renewal and rebuilding - new growth, restored landscapes, and community recovery.

SECTION 4: SUBMISSION RULES

- Up to 6 images per category.
- Each image must include: Title (max 10 words) + 150-word description.

METHOD OF SUBMISSION

All photographs must be submitted exclusively through a digital file-sharing platform, such as WeTransfer, Google Drive, or Dropbox, and sent to the following email address:

SECTION 5: TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS

- JPEG format, 3000px minimum, 300 DPI preferred, 3MB-10MB.
- High-resolution originals required if selected.
- No watermarks, logos, borders, or text.
- No Al-generated images.
- Allowed: Colour correction, exposure adjustments, cropping.
- Not allowed: Object addition/removal, composites, heavy HDR.
- EXIF must remain intact.
- Naming format: Category_YourName_ImageTitle.jpg

Eligibility

Open to all photographers - amateur and professional.

Images must be taken within the Cyclone Ditwah period, specifically from:

26th November 2025 to the present date of submission.

Only photographs captured during or after Cyclone Ditwah will be accepted.

SECTION 6: COPYRIGHT & USAGE

Photographers retain full copyright.

ASPAS receives a non-exclusive license to print, frame, and exhibit selected images.

SECTION 7: JUDGING

Competition judging will be take place on 20th, 22nd, 23rd & 24th of January 2026 Judges' decision is final.
